Item 1

Escreen Inc., AND ANY PARENTS, PREDECESSORS, AND AFFILIATES

The franchisor is Escreen, Inc. (“we,” “us,” or “our”). “You” means the person to whom we grant a franchise. If you are a corporation, partnership, limited liability company, or other entity, your owners must sign our “Guaranty and Assumption of Obligations,” which means that all of our Franchise Agreement’s provisions (Exhibit B) also will apply to your owners. (See Item 15)

We incorporated in Florida on June 1, 2006. Our principal business address is 2331 5th. Ave. Suite 111 Orlando, Florida 33317. We operate under our corporate name and the trademarks described in Item 13 (the “Marks”). We do not do business or intend to do business under any other names. Our parent, Edwards Screen Services, Inc., also is a Florida corporation and is located at our address. We currently have no predecessors or affiliates required to be included in this Item (except as provided below). If we have an agent in your state for service of process, we disclose that agent in Exhibit A.

We grant franchises for centers operating under the Edwards Screen Services™ name and other Marks. (For reference purposes in this disclosure document, we call the centers in our system Edwards Screen Services™ Centers”. Edwards Screen Services™ Centers offer home and business sales and installation of window screens and other coverings.

Items are sold according to specified procedures. If you acquire a franchise, you must operate your Center according to our business formats, methods, procedures, designs, layouts, standards, and specifications.

Your Center will offer products and services to the general public throughout the year and compete with other home and business screen installation services and screen manufacturers. The market for your type of products and services generally is developed and very competitive. Despite this competition, we believe that Edwards Screen Services™ Centers appeal to consumers because of product and service quality. Because sales of screen services generally increase in good weather, your sales may be seasonal.

We began offering franchises for Edwards Screen Services™ Centers in February 1, 2008. We do not operate any Edwards Screen Services™ Centers, although we may do so in the future. Our affiliate Escreen Inc., whose principal business address is 2331 5th. Ave. Suite 111 Orlando, Florida 33317 has operated at least one Edwards Screen Services™ Center since 2006 and currently operates One (1) Center(s). We have no other business activities and have not offered franchises in other lines of business. Escreen Inc. has not offered franchises in any line of business.

There are no laws or regulations that apply specifically to the industry in which Edwards Screen Services™ Centers operate. However, you must comply with laws and regulations that apply generally to all building and remodeling services. You should investigate these laws and regulations.
